Potential Places to Search

- In clover/alfalfa fields, pastures, meadows, prairies and open fields with an abundance of flowers.
- In wooded and forested areas.
- Along and in creeks and streams.
- Along and in ponds and lakes.
- In wetlands (bogs, fens, marshes, and swamps).
- Along roadsides, particularly through wooded areas.
- Along powerline and railroad rights-of-way.
- At mud puddles, damp sand and gravel along sand and gravel roads.
- Under rocks, lumber, rotten logs and stumps (Be aware for snakes).
- Under bark of trees (e.g. Shag-bark Hickory).
- In leaf litter.
- At bright outside lights (homes, stores, gas stations, etc.).
- In your home (on windowsills, in light fixtures, in basements).
- Around the perimeter of your home
- In your yard at flowers, on bushes and trees, and in the grass.
- On people.
- On farm animals.
- On pets.
- At animal scat and dung.
- Under animal carcasses (roadkill).
- At rotting fruit.
- At tree sap flows.
